Writing	<ul> <li>create a lesson to share knowledge of key historical figures</li> <li>Teachers can create screencasting lessons for editing and writing strategies</li> </ul>
vviicing	<ul> <li>Teachers can create screencasting lessons for editing and writing strategies</li> <li>Students can create a book by drawing illustrations or importing pics and then writing a narrative</li> </ul>
