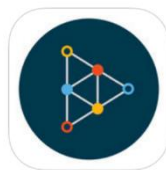

Educreations is a unique interactive whiteboard and screencasting tool that's simple, powerful, and fun to use. Annotate, animate, and narrate nearly any type of content as you explain any concept. Teachers can create short instructional videos and share them instantly with students, or ask students to show what they know and help friends learn something new.

Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students can solve a math equation or word problem and record an explanation of their thinking/strategy• Teacher can give students a completed problem and ask them to determine if it is solved correctly and explain why or why now• Students can go on a geometry hunt (shapes, types of lines, etc.) and take pictures to use in a lesson to demonstrate understanding of each
Reading	<p>Students can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• create a movie poster to advertise a story• create a new product related to the story• write and perform the inner dialogue of a character in the story at a particular point in the story• write and perform the lyrics of a song the main characters would sing if they became a singer• Characters can be reconstructed to create new endings to the story.
Science	<p>Students can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• annotate on top of a diagram and explain each term• define vocabulary and create images and audio explanation of each• classify plants, animals or states of matter.• begin a scientific journal where they sketch or illustrate the steps to their science fair project.
Social Studies	<p>Students can locate and import a map and:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• mark various landforms• draw paths to show where explorers traveled and color code for each explorer• mark and explain key battles in history• create timelines for important events• create a lesson to share knowledge of key historical figures
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teachers can create screencasting lessons for editing and writing strategies• Students can create a book by drawing illustrations or importing pics and then writing a narrative• Students can use images/drawings to create non-fiction writing pieces
Other Ideas	<p>Field trips:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• students can take photos on the field trip and import those to create a lesson to demonstrate what was learned <p>Music:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students listen to music and describe and illustrate the music as they are listening to it (active listening) <p>Art:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Insert a visual art piece and write or record your interpretation of the piece

App Smashing Ideas	<p>Students can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tellegami - create Gamis and import those into their Educreations lesson • Chatterpix - create short videos and import into lessons • Popplet Lite – import mind map and create a lesson to explain their thinking or plan for their writing • Educreations lessons can be exported to other apps such as Seesaw or Edmodo to share and gain feedback from peers and family members.
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Eraser will give you options to: clear page, clear ink or clear recording

- Click on the pen to activate the pen so you can draw
- To choose pen color, click on a colored circle.
- To change the pen color, press and hold on a colored circle and you can change it in the pop-up menu
